5	Explain how to read the train timetable.	The columns show the train number at the top (1, 2, 3 etc) and below it shows the time each train stops. The rows show the stations the train stops at (Plymouth, Devonport etc). To find the time the train will arrive at a station, find the correct train number in at the top of the column, find the station on the row and find where the row and column meet.

Pupils may select the first flight available and explain that this is the first flight you could take. They may select a different flight and explain that you would need time to get through check in and security after arriving. Accept answers that have an appropriate explanation.

12	Questions about flight timetable.	a. 1h 25, b. 1h 20, c. 1h 35
13	Javan says that flight 8 takes 2 hours and 35 minutes to get to Dublin. Is he correct? Explain.	Javan is incorrect. The flight takes 1 hour and 25 minutes. Javan has subtracted 15 minutes from 50 minutes then subtracted 8 hours from 10 hours. He has calculated the difference between 8:15 and 10:50.
14	Create a timetable for either a full day at school or your ideal full day at school.	Answers will vary. Encourage the pupils to focus on the durations of lessons and start and end times as this is more important than the accuracy of their day.
