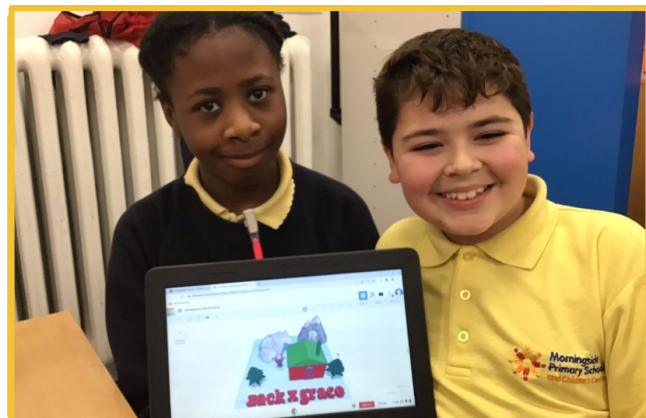

Our Learning this week...



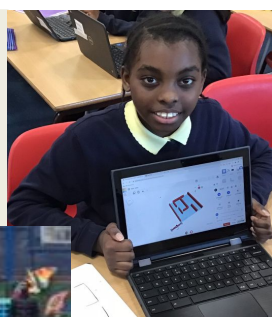
Mutual Respect and Tolerance

Year 2 explored why people wanted to go to the moon. We thought of questions to ask our very own Neil Armstrong.

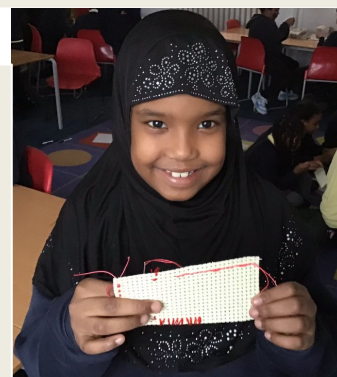


Year 5 used Tinkerpad to design and make some amazing mazes in their computing lesson this week.

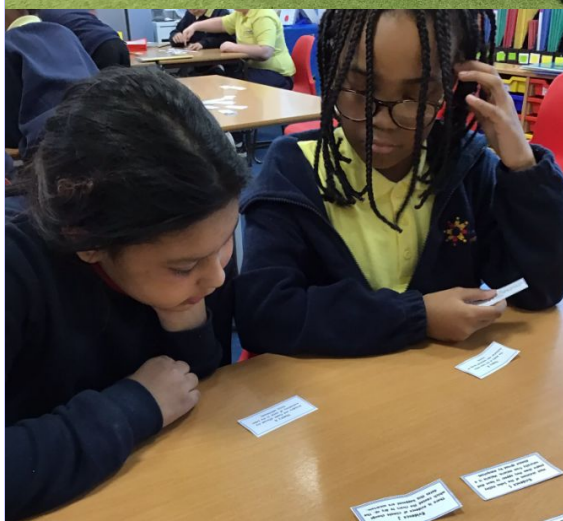
Year 3&4 Tag Rugby played very well



Year 4 learned 3 different sewing techniques in their Design and Technology lesson this week

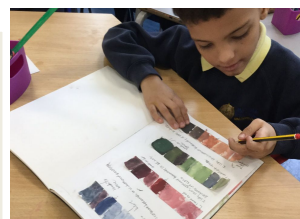


Year 1 followed instructions carefully to make their windsocks. They then tested them outside.
